The *PATCH for Teens* lesson is intended to provide young people ages 12-18 with the basic knowledge and skills to become actively involved in their own health care. The content was developed WITH youth FOR youth and is designed to be an empowering experience for young people to get the care they need and deserve.

About the Lesson

Teachers, health-related professionals, youth workers, and other adults can cover the material in 45-90 minutes (completed all at once or over the course of multiple sessions) depending on individual learning needs and activities included. It can be integrated into existing programming or school health curricula to fulfill certain components of the National Health Education Standards:

- Standard 1 - Core Concepts
- Standard 2 - Analyzing Influences
- Standard 4 - Interpersonal Communication
- Standard 8 - Advocacy

Learning Objectives

1. Teens will understand the importance of learning to manage their own health care experiences.
2. Teens will learn how to advocate for their own health and well-being in health care settings.
3. Teen will explore steps they can take to make sure they get the care they need and deserve.
