Leadership Lab is a unique opportunity for those affiliated or working with jurisdictional Title V programs (staff, consultants, volunteers) to accelerate their professional development in a way that is framed by the **MCH Leadership Competencies** and guided by adult learning principles.

- Exposure to information and resources that are relevant for your current and future roles
- Development and continuous revision of and individualized leadership plans
- Collaborative activities and thoughtful discussions
- A peer learning and accountability network
- Ongoing support from a matched mentor and AMCHP staff

JOIN OUR COHORTS!

FAMILY LEADERS COHORT (FLC)

For parents or family of a child or youth served by a Title V program that have demonstrated community leadership and are AMCHP Family Delegates for their jurisdiction; are staff, consult with, or volunteer for a Title V program; or work with a Title V funded program

NEW DIRECTOR LEADERS COHORT (NDLC)

For Title V administrators (Title V, MCH, or CYSHCN Directors or senior reports) who have been in this capacity for three years or less.

NEXT GENERATION LEADERS COHORT (NextGen)

For anyone affiliated with jurisdictional Title V who is either interested in future leadership roles within their organization, or who have not previously participated in an AMCHP leadership development program.

MCH EPI PEER-TO-PEER COHORT (MCH EPI P2P)

For epidemiologists and Data Specialists who currently work with a Title V MCH/CYSCHN program, have expressed support for their participation from a supervisor, and will not be participating in a concurrent mentorship, field assignment, fellowship, or AMCHP leadership development activity.

ADOLESCENT HEALTH LEADERS COHORT (AHLIC)

For state Adolescent Health Coordinators (SAHCs); jurisdictional health department employees responsible for managing public health programs that target adolescents and partners with Title V, MCH/Title V Director interested in building skills to strengthen their program's adolescent health focus.
