

Replication Project Readiness Checklist

Use the suggested steps below to help you successfully apply for a Replication Project.

November

- Identify the key audience** you'd like to support/focus on.
- Identify the needs and interests** of your key audience (e.g., surveys, conversations, focus groups, etc.).
- Look through the MCH Innovations Database** to identify the practice (Emerging, Promising, or Best) that is best aligned with the needs, capacity, and context of your organization, key audience, and partners.

December

- Contact the practice** you identified to learn more about its implementation and any lessons learned.
- Make sure you have leadership support** to participate in this opportunity.
- Identify who will support** the implementation of the practice (at least 3-5 people).

January

- Sign up for an Exploratory Call** to meet with AMCHP staff and determine your readiness to apply based on completion of previous steps.
- Begin your application.**

February

- Work on completing your application.**

March

- Submit your application** to AMCHP.
