Priority: Decrease overweight and obesity among children

Population Domain: Child Health



OBJECTIVES

- Increase the rate of Double Up Food Bucks purchases per 1000 SNAP recipients in the targeted counties from 18.03 on October 1, 2021 to 8.58 on September 30, 2025.



STRATEGY

Promote policy, systems, and environmental change strategies to increase physical activity and promote access to healthy food and beverages.



ACTIVITY

Collaborate with non-profits in East Tennessee to increase access to fresh fruit and vegetables for SNAP recipients through the **Double Up Food Bucks Program**.
